- 1. Section I, Instruction to Bidders, ITB Clause no.21, Bid Security page no. 19 & 20**
The ITB clause 21. Bid Security has been amended as follows.

Bid Security</p>	<p>21.1 The Bidder shall furnish as part of its bid, in original form a Bid Security as <i>specified in the BDS</i>.</p> <p>21.2 If a bid security is specified pursuant to ITB 21.1, the bid security shall be a demand guarantee in any of the following forms at the Bidder's option:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">(a) original copy of an unconditional bank guarantee from "A" class commercial bank or;(b) original copy of cash deposit voucher in the Employer's Account as <i>specified in BDS</i>. <p>In case of a bank guarantee, the Bid Security shall be submitted using the Bid Security Form included in Section IV, Bidding Forms. The form must include the complete name of the Bidder. The Bid Security shall be valid for minimum thirty (30) days beyond the end of the validity period of the bid. This shall also apply if the period for bid validity is extended.</p> <p>The bid security issued by any foreign Bank outside Nepal must be counter guaranteed by an "A" class Commercial Bank in Nepal.</p> <p>21.3 If a bid Security is required in accordance with ITB 21.1, any Bid not accompanied by an enforceable and compliant Bid Security in accordance with ITB 21.2, shall be rejected by the Purchaser as nonresponsive.</p> <p>21.4 If a Bid Security is specified pursuant to ITB 21.1, the Bid Security of unsuccessful Bidders shall be returned within three (3) days</p>
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	<p>upon the successful Bidder furnishing of the signed Contract Agreement and the Performance Security pursuant to ITB 42.</p> <p>21.5 If a Bid Security is specified pursuant to ITB 21.1, the Bid Security of the successful Bidder shall be returned as promptly as possible once the successful Bidder has signed the Contract Agreement and furnished the required Performance Security.</p> <p>21.6 The Bid Security may be forfeited:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">(a) if a Bidder withdraws its Bid during the period of bid validity specified by the Bidder on the Bid Submission Form, except as provided in ITB 20.2; or(b) if the successful Bidder fails to:<ul style="list-style-type: none">(i) sign the Contract in accordance with ITB 42; or(ii) furnish a Performance Security in accordance with ITB 42. <p>21.7 The Bid Security of a JV must be in the name of the JV that submits the bid. If the JV has not been legally constituted at the time of bidding, the Bid Security shall be in the names of all future partners as named in the letter of intent mentioned in ITB 17.1.</p>
